5 6	The regular meeting of the Heritage Greens Community Development District Board of Directors was held on Monday, October 16 th , 2023, at 10:00 a.m. at the HGCDD

16	ROLL CALL/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
17	Mr. Dorrill called the meeting to order and advised that the meeting was properly
18	noticed. Four board members were present at the meeting establishing a quorum. Mrs.
19 20	Connor was not in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited in unison. Per Mr. Shelton's request, a moment of silence was observed for the people in Israel.
21	APPROVAL OF AGENDA
22 23	Mr. Dorrill added item 6D to the agenda, an update on the traffic accident. On MOTION by Mrs. Pitts and a second by Mr. Joos, the agenda was unanimously approved
24	as ammended.
25	PUBLIC COMMENT
26	No public comments were received at this time.
27	APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 2023
28	On a MOTION by Mr. Meszaros and a second by Mr. Joos, the minutes were
29	unanimously accepted as presented.

1 **FINANCIALS**

- 2 Mr. Dorrill presented the 11-month financials as of the end of August 2023. The balance
- 3 sheet shows \$196,000 in cash and assets, \$19,000 in the operating account, and
- 4 \$176,000 in the reserve account. There were \$1,900 in payables at the end of the
- 5 month. Year to date revenues so far are \$260,296 against an original budget of
- 6 \$263,000 for the year including the discount credit for assessments. Next month the
- 7 preliminary year ending financials will be presented. Mr. Dorrill may present budget
- 8 amendments at the next meeting to reflect some of the capital projects that were done
- 9 this year outside of the budget.
- 10 On a MOTION by Mr. Joos and a second by Mrs. Pitts, the financials were
- 11 unanimously accepted as presented.
- 12 MANAGERS REPORT
- 13 A. Review/Approval of FY 2024 Insurance Coverage
- 14 Mr. Dorrill bound coverage effective October 1st. The total premium increase was
- 15 \$2,000. About \$1,200 of that was in the property category. There were modest
- increases in both the liability and public liability categories of the insurance. The total
- 17 overall increase was about 27%.

18 B. Review/Approval of Christmas Lighting

- 19 Mr. Dorrill hired a new vendor to put holiday lights up in the community. The vendor
- 20 used in recent years was un-responsive for months until last Friday. In the interim,
- 21 alternative arrangements were made to complete the work with Trimmers, a vendor
- 22 used by Mr. Dorrill in other communities. The proposal from Trimmers was \$6,000, only
- 23 slightly more than last year. There are new Sylvester palms by the entrance that will be
- 24 wrapped in addition to the big oak tree and the guard gate. The deposit has been paid
- and the lights will be activated on Black Friday, the day after thanksgiving.

26 C. Update on Tree Trimming Proposal

- 27 The budget for tree trimming at the entrance is \$2,000. Dorrill Management solicited a
- 28 proposal for a revised amount of work just at the front entrance, not to include sabal
- 29 palms by the school gate. The trimming of those sabal palms was not budgeted for.
- 30 Earthcare, the Districts landscaper, is the company providing the proposal. Anytown is
- another vendor that was discussed at the meeting who could do the work. Mr. Shelton
- 32 suggested seeking an additional proposal from them. Mr. Christopher Dorrill said that

- 1 Anytown is booked out right now and he is wanting to get the trees trimmer prior to the
- 2 holiday lights being installed. Mr. Shelton is going to contact his connection at Anytown
- 3 to get a price for trimming the sabal palms that are not included in this scope of work at
- 4 the front entrance. It was mentioned that Anytown is doing the trees in the 'club homes'
- 5 on October 31^{st.} It was suggested to see if they could pick up the extra work when they
- 6 would already be in the community.

7 D. Traffic Accident

- 8 Mr. Dorrill has opened a claim and has contacted Carter Fence to do the repair. The
- 9 entire panel is going to be replaced. Mr. Christopher Dorrill may also ask for a price for
- 10 the section that had a tree fall on it, to replace that second panel at the same time. The
- 11 Sheriff's Department was contacted by Mr. Dorrill to get a copy of the police report so
- 12 they could subrogate the claim and go against whoever was driving the car and
- 13 responsible for the damage. Mr. Dorrill had told the Sheriff's department that the
- 14 accident occurred on Friday afternoon but realized that was not correct. The Board
- 15 believes that it occurred overnight on Thursday. Mr. Shelton saw the damage Friday
- 16 morning.

17 **SUPERVISOR REQUESTS**

- 18 A Board Member mentioned that the flowers are looking weak. Mr. Dorrill shared that
- 19 Keepin' It Green is the company that installs the annuals and will be replacing the
- 20 flowers, hopefully, in advance of Thanksgiving. A Board Member commented that it
- 21 would look better if the flowers were pulled and mulch was put down in the interim.
- 22 Mr. Shelton shared that he has received about two or three complaints from residents
- 23 who have gone to the gate late at night in rental cars and have been let in by the Envera
- 24 agent without the agent answering or asking for any information prior to allowing them
- in. Mr. Dorrill said that his company will send an email to Envera with a complaint. Mr.
- 26 Shelton also asked if they could solicit proposals for a security guard to work at the gate
- from 7pm-5am. He just wants a proposal to look at and consider for now, it does not
- 28 mean that the system will be changing.
