- 18 Mr. Neil Dorrill called the meeting to order and advised that the meeting was properly

21 APPROVAL OF AGENDA

22 The agenda was unanimously approved as presented on a MOTION by Mrs. Pitts

26 APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES FOR OCTOBER 2023

- 27 No changes were made. The minutes were unanimously accepted as presented on

1 FINANCIALS

2 The preliminary, unaudited year end financials were presented. The District has about \$190.000 in cash. \$10,000 is in the operating fund with the remaining \$176,000 in 3 4 reserves. There were \$4,000 in payables in September. Year to date non-ad-valorem 5 assessments were within \$2,500 of the original forecast. Mr. Dorrill is going to follow up 6 with The Club about their portion of the reserve report charges. He needs to make sure 7 that The Club has paid all appropriate charges. Total revenues over expenses were 8 \$7,000 over budget at year end. When the audit is presented in the Spring there will be 9 a budget amendment to move money from reserves into operating to cover the overage 10 in expenses. On a MOTION by Mr. Meszaros and a second Mr. Joos, the financials

11 were unanimously accepted.

12 MANAGERS REPORT

13 A. Gate Repair Status

- 14 Mr. Dorrill will follow up with the assigned insurance adjuster about the fence repair. In
- absence of badge or tag number or physical address the sheriff is unable to provide
- 16 information on the accident.

17 B. Envera

- 18 There continues to be issues with Envera allowing people through without receiving any
- 19 information from them. Mr. Dorrill is going to have a phone call with them or meet with a
- 20 sales representative to get things straightened out. He will hold off, if necessary, on
- 21 paying them in order to get their attention on this issue. The Board agreed with this
- 22 course of action.

23 C. Tree Trimming

Tree trimming was accomplished and Mr. Christopher Dorrill was thanked for his effortin getting that done.

26 D. Christmas Lighting

- 27 Christmas lights are installed and plugged in. All Board members noted that they look
- great. Mr. Dorrill commented that the Christmas palms that in front of the guard gate
- 29 conflict with the American flag as the flag tends to get caught in them. He would like to
- 30 get those removed in the future.
