16 17 18	Mr. Dorrill called the meeting to order and advised that the meeting was properly noticed. 3 of 5 board members were present in person. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited in unison.
19 20	FINAL APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF PROPOSED FY 2024 GENERAL FUND BUDGET
21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28	There are 527 equivalent residential units within the community, the proposed budget is advertised for an increase that will go from \$499 to \$551, which is about a 10% increase. The budget was previously reviewed at a budget workshop in May. The total non-ad valorem assessments proposed are \$290,175, total revenue with other miscellaneous interest earnings and revenues associated with the transponders have a combined budget of \$281,375. The expenditures are the same, the principal reason for the increase this year was to fund the reserve for capital and reserve for contingency to offset capital expenditures this year for the new entryway landscaping and sidewalk

- offset capital expenditures this year for the new entryway landscaping and sidewalk
 connecting to Immokalee Road. These assessment rates remain some of the lowest in
- 30 SW Florida.

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1 PUBLIC COMMENT

- 2 No public comment was received at this time.
- 3 A. Resolution 2023-2: Adoption of the Final General Fund Budget John/Dale
- A motion is needed to approve Resolution 2023-2, which is the resolution adopting the final general fund budget as outlined in Mr. Dorrill's presentation.

- 11 non-ad valorem assessments for fiscal year 2024.

12 On a MOTION by Mr. Shelton and a second by Mr. Joos Resolution 2023-3 is 13 approved.

- end of the month. On income statement, received \$3,056 in non-ad valorem
- assessment in month of May, these were either late tax payments or investor purchases
- 26 at tax auction if the delinquent tax payments were not received. Various expenditures
- are all in accordance with the adopted budget or will be trued up in the final month of

- the fiscal year, which will be in September. Overall, the district remains in a good cashposition.
- The financials were accepted on a MOTION by Mr. Meszaros and a second by Mr.
 Joos.
