20	APPROVAL OF AGENDA
21	Mr. Dorrill added item 6c. to the agenda under Stormwater Assessment

1 FINANCIALS

- 2 Mr. Dorrill reviewed the November financials and the second month of the new fiscal
- 3 year. HGCDD received the first payment of \$13,000 from the Golf Course for the illegal
- 4 clearing in the preserve. \$225,000 in cash against \$17,000 in payables. \$50,000 came
- 5 in during the month of November from residents. We will see another large amount
- 6 coming in December.
- 7 Total expenditures year to date are \$39,000. We are substantially under budget after
- 8 two months.
- 9 A MOTION to accept the financials was made by Dale Mezaros, and a second by
- 10 Barbara Pitts, with all in favor.
- 11 **OLD BUSINESS**
- 12 A. Entry Wall Trimming
- Hedges were trimmed along the wall near the schools. Vines, with the orange flower,
- that are growing on the wall are to be scheduled to be trimmed. The vines are attaching
- to the wall and overtime it could damage the wall. We told the landscaper to chop it off
- at the top. Brazilian Pepper is also scheduled to be removed at the entrance.
- 17 MANAGER'S REPORT
- 18 GOLF COURSE SIDEWALK EASMENT
- 19 Golf course is planning on giving the CDD the property where we would like to place the
- 20 sidewalk. They don't want to fool around with easements and would rather just give that
- 21 piece to the CDD.
- 22 Once it is the CDD's land we can continue to move forward with the project.
- 23 **STORMWATER ASSESSMENT**
- All local governments are to have a stormwater assessment in part to make sure
- everyone's drainage is working properly and that we aren't causing any damage. Catch
- 26 basins and pipes are to be examined by our engineer.
